The questionnaire on the reverse side of this page is designed to help provide an estimate of your financial aid eligibility. It is not an application for financial aid. An official financial aid award letter cannot be provided until you have been admitted and we have received the results of your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2009-2010.

This questionnaire is appropriate for determining eligibility for dependent students only. If you have questions about applying to Alderson-Broaddus College, please contact the Admissions Office. ** The term “parents” on this questionnaire is defined to be the student’s mother and/or father, or adoptive parents. If the student’s parents are separated or divorced, provide information for the parent with whom the student lived for the greater portion of the year. If the student’s natural parents have divorced and remarried, report information regarding the stepparent also, if the student lives in his/her household. If one of the student’s parents is deceased, report information for only the surviving parent. (Note that grandparents, foster parents, and legal guardians are not parents.)*

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DEPENDENT STUDENTS

19. **Number of family members:** Write in the number of people that your parents will support between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010. Include yourself, your parents, and other children who will get more than half of their support from your parents. If your parents support others, call us to determine if they should be included.
20. **Number in College:** Of the children included in question 19, how many will be enrolled at least half-time in college degree or certificate programs between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010? Be sure to include yourself. If your parents are in college, do **NOT** include them.
24. **2007 Income earned from work:** If you answered question 22, include “wages, salaries, tips, etc.” from your parents’ 2007 federal tax return. Report your father’s/stepfather’s and mother’s/stepmother’s earnings separately.

If you skipped question 22, include your parents’ earnings from work in 2007. Add up earnings from your parents’ W-2 forms and other earnings from work that are not reported on W-2 forms.

25. **2007 Untaxed income:** Include any deductible IRA/Keogh payments made in 2007 or untaxed portions of 2007 payments to 401(k) and 403(b) plans, housing, food and living allowances for military, clergy, etc., earned income credit from the 2007 tax form, 2007 nontaxable interest and dividends, and any welfare benefits (other than food stamps), untaxed Social Security benefits, child support, worker’s compensation, etc., received in 2007.
30. **Real estate and investments:** Include real estate (excluding primary residence), stocks, bonds, money market funds, mutual funds, CDs, trust funds, commodities, precious metals and other investments; Do not include the value of the family home or retirement plans.
